Proposed additions, amendment and/or repeal of regulations, Chapter 637B of the Nevada Administrative Code.

1. Introduction – Open Public Hearing

The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested parties regarding the adoption of regulations that pertain to LCB File No. R129-15, Chapter 637B of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The proposed regulation will provide clarity for the public, individuals and licensees through regulation by establishing provisions concerning the examination given to persons who wish to engage in the practice of fitting and dispensing hearing aids; establishing provisions concerning a program of in-service training for apprentice hearing aid specialists; authorizing a hearing aid specialist or dispensing audiologist to delegate certain duties to certain persons not licensed to engage in the practice of audiology, speech-language pathology or fitting and dispensing hearing aids; establishing certain duties of hearing aid specialists and dispensing audiologists; requiring licensees to prepare and retain certain client records; establishing provisions concerning requirements for continuing education; establishing provisions concerning the renewal and reinstatement of certain expired licenses; establishing certain fees to be charged and collected by the Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.
