## **AGENDA ITEM 3**

Case A20-01: Scott Sumrall, AuD; License # A-2133
Public Hearing to Determine Whether There Has Been a Violation of the Consent Decree Executed on January 22, 2020

During its January 22, 2020 meeting, the Board reviewed and accepted the Consent Decree on Case A20-01, Scott Sumrall, License # A-2133 related to allegations of unlicensed practice.

The Consent Decree is attached for review, with the Stipulated Adjudication and Violation sections highlighted in yellow from pages 6-8 for the Board's review.

The terms of the Consent Decree included the following:

1. License placed on probation for one (1) year.

Ends: 4/21/2021 Status: Ongoing

2. Within 45 days of the approval and execution of the Consent Decree on January 22, 2020, pay attorney's fees and costs assessed at \$1,389.24. May be paid in full or through payment plan arranged within 45 days of the executed Consent Decree.

Due: 3/7/2020 Status: Past Due

See attached correspondence. Mr. Sumrall was provided instructions on multiple occasions for making payment or requesting a payment plan. When the fees initially became past due in March 2020 he was granted an extension to pay but has yet to make payment.

3. Within three (3) months of the date of the executed Consent Decree, completion of six (6) hours of Board approved continuing education on professional ethics.

Due: 4/22/2020 Status: Past Due

See attached correspondence. Mr. Sumrall indicated in his email dated 3/30/2020 that the CE would be completed that week, but Board staff have not received any documentation of completed CE hours to date.

4. Within three (3) months of the date of the executed Consent Decree, sit for and pass both the written and practical dispensing examinations.

Due: 4/22/2020 Written Exam Status: Passed 3/9/2020 Practical Exam Status: Past Due
The Board office received notification from IHS that Mr. Sumrall passed the written examination on
3/9/2020. He contacted the Board on 3/26/2020 to inquire as to whether his score was received but has not requested to take the practical examination.

5. Within one (1) week of completion of the exams listed in #4, above, submit the required Audiology Dispensing Endorsement application and pay all associated application fees.

# BEFORE THE STATE OF NEVADA SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AUDIOLOGY AND HEARING AID DISPENSING BOARD

#### CONSENT DECREE

The State of Nevada Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board ("BOARD") having jurisdiction over licensee SCOTT SUMRALL ("RESPONDENT"), pursuant to NRS 637B.010; a complaint against said licensee having been received alleging violations of the Nevada statutes and regulations controlling the practice of fitting and dispensing hearing aids and the practice of audiology; and the parties being mutually desirous of settling the controversy between them relative to the pending complaints;

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED between the undersigned parties that this matter shall be settled and resolved upon the following terms:

#### **VOLUNTARY WAIVER OF RIGHTS**

RESPONDENT is aware of, understands, and has been advised of the effect of this Consent Decree, which he has carefully read and fully acknowledges. RESPONDENT has had the opportunity to consult with competent counsel of his choice.

RESPONDENT has freely and voluntarily entered into this Consent Decree, and he is aware of his rights to contest the charges pending against him. These rights include representation by an attorney at his own expense, the right to file an answer in response to a formal complaint, the right to a public hearing on any charges or allegations formally filed, the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses called to testify against him, the right to present evidence on his own behalf, the right to testify on his own behalf, the right to receive written findings of fact and conclusions of law supporting the decision on the merits of the complaint, and the right to obtain judicial review of the decision. All of these

 rights are being voluntarily waived by RESPONDENT, in exchange for the BOARD'S acceptance of this Consent Decree.

If the Consent Decree is not accepted by the BOARD, no member of the BOARD will be disqualified from further hearing of this matter, by reason of his or her consideration of the Consent Decree and RESPONDENT hereby waives any claim of bias or prejudice based upon said consideration by any member of the BOARD in any subsequent disciplinary hearing conducted by the BOARD.

#### **JURISDICTION**

RESPONDENT acknowledges that the BOARD has jurisdiction over him and the conduct that has precipitated this Consent Decree. RESPONDENT acknowledges that the BOARD has the legal power and authority to take disciplinary action, including, but not limited to, the revocation of his license to the practice audiology in Nevada.

RESPONDENT acknowledges that the BOARD will retain jurisdiction over this matter until all terms and conditions set forth in this Consent Decree have been met to the satisfaction of the BOARD.

#### PUBLICATION OF CONSENT DECREE

RESPONDENT acknowledges that at the time this Consent Decree becomes effective, it also becomes a public document and will be reported to the State of Nevada, Legislative Council Bureau, Disciplinary Action Reporting System; and such other national databases as required by law. It is also understood that any meeting during which the BOARD considers and accepts or rejects this Consent Decree is open to the public and that the minutes of the BOARD meeting are a public document, available for inspection by any person so requesting.

#### CONTINGENCY

By signing the Consent Decree, RESPONDENT understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to amend or rescind the Consent Decree.

The parties understand and agree that facsimile copies of this Consent Decree, including facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

This Consent Decree is intended to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral).

#### **IDEMNIFICATION**

RESPONDENT, for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby indemnifies and holds harmless the State of Nevada, the BOARD, the Nevada Attorney General's office and each of their members, agents and employees in their individual and representative capacities against any and all claims, suits, demands, actions, debts, damages, costs, charges, and expenses, including court costs and attorney's fees against any persons, entities, as well as all liability, losses, and damages of any nature whatsoever that the persons and entities named in this paragraph shall have or may at any time sustain or suffer by reason of this investigation, this disciplinary action, this settlement or its lawful administration.

The admissions made by RESPONDENT herein are only for the purposes of this proceeding, or any other proceedings in which the BOARD or other professional licensing agency is involved, and shall not be admissible in any other criminal or civil proceeding.

### STIPULATED FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

RESPONDENT understands the nature of the allegations under consideration by the BOARD. He acknowledges that the conduct described below constitutes violations of the Nevada Speech-Language, Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board Practice Act (NRS and NAC 637B). He acknowledges that if this matter were to be taken to a disciplinary hearing before the BOARD, the following allegations could be proven by preponderance of the evidence and that by acknowledging the same, he is subject to disciplinary action by the BOARD:

1. RESPONDENT was licensed by the BOARD as an Audiologist on or about June 20, 2017, through the present day.

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- 2. RESPONDENT was authorized by the BOARD to take the ILE Written Examination in January 10, 2018, August 2, 2018 and August 21, 2019. As of the date of this Complaint and Notice of Hearing, RESPONDENT has not completed the examination requirements to obtain the dispensing endorsement to his Audiologist license to fit and dispense hearing aids.
- 3. The complaint was received by the BOARD on or about August 1, 2019, alleging that RESPONDENT, while working at Sparks Hearing and Balance and/or Modern Audiology, engaged in unprofessional conduct by fitting and dispensing hearing aids without obtaining a dispensing endorsement from the BOARD.
- 4. RESPONDENT's actions constitute unprofessional conduct and a violation of ethical standards.
- 5. This conduct violates NRS 637B.205 which states that an audiologist or an applicant for a license to engage in the practice of audiology who wishes to engage in the practice of fitting and dispensing hearing aids must: 1. Request an endorsement of the license to engage in the practice of fitting and dispensing hearing aids; and 2. Pass an examination prescribed by the Board pursuant to NRS 637B.194. The examination must be identical to the examination required for the licensure of hearing aid specialists.
- 6. This conduct violates NAC 637B.042(1) which states that a licensee shall not misrepresent, in advertising or otherwise, his or her education, training, type of license or certificate, qualifications, competence or service, or the results to be achieved if he or she provides service to a client.
- 7. This conduct violates NAC 637B.042(8) which states that a licensee shall not attempt to diagnose, prescribe for, treat or provide advice for any problem which is outside of his or her field of competence, the scope of the practice of audiology, speech-language pathology or fitting and dispensing hearing aids or the scope of his or her license or certificate.

- This conduct violates NAC 637B.042(13) which states that a licensee shall 8. comply with the provisions of this chapter and chapter 637B of NRS and all other applicable federal laws and regulations.
- 9. That the foregoing facts constitute grounds for initiating disciplinary action pursuant to NRS 637B.250.
  - That pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 642.5175: 10.
    - 1. The grounds for initiating disciplinary action pursuant to this chapter are:

(a) Unprofessional conduct.

(b) Conviction of:

(1) A violation of any federal or state law regarding the possession, distribution or use of any controlled substance or any dangerous drug as defined in chapter 454 of NRS;

(2) A felony or gross misdemeanor relating to the practice of audiology, speech-language pathology or fitting and dispensing hearing aids;

(3) A violation of any of the provisions of NRS 616D.200,

616D.220, 616D.240 or 616D.300 to 616D.440, inclusive; or (4) Any offense involving moral turpitude.

(c) Gross or repeated malpractice, which may be evidenced by claims of malpractice settled against a practitioner.

(d) Professional incompetence.

(e) Operation of a medical facility, as defined in NRS 449.0151, at any time during which:

(1) The license of the facility is suspended or revoked; or An act or omission occurs which results in the suspension or revocation of the license pursuant to NRS 449.160. This paragraph applies to an owner or other principal responsible for the operation of the facility.

2. As used in this section, "unprofessional conduct" includes, without limitation:

(a) Conduct that is harmful to the public health or safety;

(b) Obtaining a license through fraud or misrepresentation of a material fact;

(c) Suspension or revocation of a license to engage in the practice of audiology, speech-language pathology or fitting and dispensing hearing aids; and

(d) A violation of any provision of:

Federal law concerning the practice of audiology, speech-language pathology or fitting and dispensing hearing aids or any regulations adopted pursuant thereto, including, without limitation, 21 C.F.R. §§ 801.420 and 801.421;
(2) NRS 597.264 to 597.2667, inclusive, or any regulations

adopted pursuant thereto; or

This chapter or any regulations adopted pursuant (3)thereto.

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- c. Within three (3) months of the approval and execution of this Consent

  Decree, RESPONDENT must sit for and pass both the written and practical dispensing

  examinations.
- d. RESPONDENT must submit the required Audiology Dispensing Endorsement application and associated fee(s) within one (1) week of completion of the written and practical International Licensing Examination (ILE) exams.
- 2. RESPONDENT shall obey all federal, state and local laws, insurance company policies or contracts and order of the BOARD, which are not inconsistent with this Consent Decree, pertaining to the practice of audiology and fitting and dispensing hearing aids in this State. Any and all violations shall be reported by RESPONDENT to the BOARD in writing within seventy-two (72) hours.
- 3. RESPONDENT is required to notify the BOARD in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after any changes in audiology employment, including self-employment, consulting or volunteering. Any notification of termination shall contain a full explanation of the circumstances surrounding it.
- 4. RESPONDENT agrees that he will be financially responsible for all requirements of this Consent Decree, including any reasonable financial assessments by the Board for the Cost of monitoring his compliance or carrying out the provisions of this Consent Decree.
- 5. After the one (1) year of probation, RESPONDENT shall submit a written request to the BOARD for termination of the probation. RESPONDENT understands that prior to terminating the probation he must prove to the BOARD's satisfaction that he has complied with all the terms and conditions of the Consent Decree. The BOARD may request additional information from RESPONDENT to determine compliance with the terms of the Consent Decree and may require him to meet with the Executive Director and BOARD counsel for further evaluation of its compliance with the Consent Decree. If the BOARD does not request additional information or initiate any further investigation, the probation shall be automatically terminated.

#### VIOLATION OF TERMS OF CONSENT DECREE

RESPONDENT understands that the BOARD may, upon thirty (30) days notice to RESPONDENT, convene a hearing for the limited purpose of establishing that there has, in fact, been a violation of the terms of this Consent Decree. If such a hearing results in a finding of a violation of this Consent Decree, the BOARD may impose any penalty upon RESPONDENT authorized by NRS 637B.280, including, but not limited to, revocation of his license to practice audiology in the State of Nevada.

In the event that a violation of the terms of the Consent Decree is alleged, RESPONDENT agrees to surrender his license to the Executive Director, if the Executive Director so requests, and refrain from practicing audiology until entry of a final order of the BOARD or a court of competent jurisdiction, whichever last occurs, regarding the alleged violation. RESPONDENT agrees to waive his right to appeal the substantive legal basis of the original disciplinary action, which is the basis for this Consent Decree. In the event an alleged violation of the Consent Decree is taken to hearing and the facts which constitute the violation are determined to be not proven, no disciplinary action shall be taken by the BOARD.

#### ACCEPTANCE BY THE BOARD

This Consent Decree shall be presented to the BOARD with a recommendation for approval from the Attorney General's Office at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the BOARD. RESPONDENT understands that the BOARD is free to accept or reject this Consent Decree, and if rejected by the BOARD, a disciplinary proceeding may be commenced.

If the Consent Decree is not accepted by the BOARD, it shall be regarded as null and void, and no member of the BOARD will be disqualified from further hearing this matter by reason of his or her consideration of the Consent Decree.

Admissions by RESPONDENT in the Consent Decree will not be regarded as evidence against him at a subsequent disciplinary hearing. RESPONDENT will be free to

defend himself and no inferences against RESPONDENT will be drawn from his 1 willingness to enter into this Consent Decree. 2 This Consent Decree will not be submitted for BOARD consideration until after it 3 has been agreed to and executed by RESPONDENT. The Consent Decree shall not become 4 effective until it has been approved by a majority of the BOARD and executed by a 5 representative member of the BOARD. 6 COMPLETE CONSENT DECREE 7 This Consent Decree embodies the entire agreement between the BOARD and 8 RESPONDENT. It may not be altered, amended, or modified without the express written 9 10 consent of the parties. On January 19, 2020, you entered into a Consent Decree with the Board to settle case number A20-01. Pursuant to paragraph 1 of the Stipulated Adjudication in the Consent Decree, you needed to submit payment to the Board in the amount of \$1,389.24 for reimbursement of attorney's fees and costs. This payment, or a request to enter into a payment plan, was due within 45 days of the January 22, 2020 execution of the Consent Decree, which was March 7, 2020. No payment was received from you by March 7, 2020. On March 12, 2020, I sent you notice via both email and Certified US Mail that the payment was past due, and allowed an extension to Friday, March 20, 2020 at 5:00pm Pacific to make payment. As of the writing of this letter, payment has still not been received. Accordingly, it is alleged that you have violated the terms of the Consent Decree.

You are hereby notified that this matter will be set for Hearing before the Board for the purposes of establishing whether you have violated the terms of the Consent Decree. If the hearing results in a finding of violation of the Consent Decree, the Board may impose the suspension of your license to practice in Nevada, or other disciplinary action as may be determined by the Board.

This letter is to provide you with notice pursuant to NRS 241.033 and NRS 241.034. In connection with the hearing to establish whether you violated the terms of the Consent Decree terms for Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board Case No. A20-01, the Board may need to consider your character, alleged misconduct, or professional competence at its meeting on Wednesday, April 29, 2020 at 4:30pm.

This information statement is in lieu of any notice that may be required pursuant to NRS 241.034.

I've made every effort to comply with the consent decree and outside of the practical exam which I'm waiting to hear when that will occur and I believe 2 hours of CE courses which will be completed this week. All aspects have been followed. Payment for legal fees will be made online today.

I respect the fact that an agreement has been made and agreed upon and am pleading that if there is any way to remove the restriction from my license it would be unbelievably appreciated as without it's removal my license is essentially of no use to me as I don't haven't and don't intend to see private pay patients and all my clientele is from disability exams which the restrictions are preventing me from doing.
