Notice of Public Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Regulations NAC 637B.036

The State of Nevada Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensing Board is proposing the addition, amendment and/or repeal of regulations pertaining to Chapter 637B of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the proposed regulation, but revised NAC 637B language has not yet been drafted. The proposed regulation would do the following:

The proposal is for consideration of revisions to NAC 637B to require a licensed Speech-Language Pathologist to hold an active Certificate of Clinical Competence (SLP-CCC) issued by the American Speech-Language Association (ASHA) in order to renew a Standard SLP license. Currently, the CCC-SLP is required to obtain the Standard SLP license. NAC 637B.036 addresses renewal of a standard license but does not contain language related to the CCC-SLP or list it as a requirement for renewal.
